

Singapore Chamber of Commerce (HK) Scholarship Awards 2008 for SingCham (HK), SA(HK), SingCham China and InterCham Members.

- **5 scholarships offered into U21Global MBA programme**
 - 5 x 50% of tuition fees for members residing in Hong Kong at the time of application
- **Selection Criteria**
 - Available to SingCham (HK), SA(HK), SingCham China and InterCham Members who strive for excellence in the business world through continuous education.
 - Award recipients are selected on a combination of:
 - academic excellence in University degree (based on transcripts provided by the applicant)
 - at least three years professional or managerial experience
 - strength of two professional references
 - other factors which will be taken into account are:
 - contribution to profession
 - contribution to industry
 - awards and other achievements in both professional and extra curricular activities
 - recognition of leadership and leadership potential, such as through awards and leadership positions

- **Terms and Conditions of Scholarship**
 - Singapore Chamber of Commerce will confirm the status of the award recipients in consultation and collaboration with the selection committee, which comprises SingCham, InterCham and U21Global members
 - The scholarships are awarded in the form of an MBA tuition fee waiver, not in the form of cash or cheques
 - The application closing date is 30th May 2008
 - The scholarships are awarded by the end of June 2008
 - Although 5 scholarships are offered, Review Committee reserves the right to offer less if the candidates' qualifications fall short of the qualifying requirements (academically or otherwise)
 - From the time of the receipt and acceptance of the scholarship offer, award recipients are required to enrol in the MBA within six months
 - Once admitted, the scholarship holder will be treated equally and fairly compared to other regular full-paying MBA students, thus all student policies and procedures as stipulated in the Student Handbook will apply to the award recipients.
 - The scholarships are applied on a pro-rata basis should scholarship holders withdraw from the MBA program
 - If a scholarship holder voluntarily withdraws from the MBA program, any request to rejoin the Programme would be evaluated on its merit. There is no guarantee that permission to rejoin would be granted; nor the scholarship.
 - Previous unsuccessful scholarship applicants are eligible to reapply for a scholarship
 - There is no impediment to the scholarship holder relocating at a future date
 - The selection committee's decisions are final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into concerning any aspect of the scholarships or the process of selection.
